## SERC Dumfries Annual Awards List 2011

### \*\* Kilometres Awards \*\*

Kilometres ridden under both SERC and EGB rules can be claimed for the following four awards only:

◆ **1: Highest Kilometres Award - Rider**

Awarded to the rider achieving the highest total kilometres, on one or more horses, in the current season – 1st January to 31st December.

◆ **2: Highest Kilometres Award - Horse**

Awarded to the horse achieving the highest total kilometres, with one or more SERC riders, in the current season – 1st January to 31st December.

◆ **3: Non-Competitive Kilometres Award**

Awarded to the horse and rider combination achieving the highest total non-competitive kilometres, not to have started more than three competitive rides, in the current season - 1st January to 31st December.

◆ **4: ER Kilometres Award**

Awarded to the horse and rider combination achieving the highest total kilometres in ER classes in the current season 1st January to 31st December.

### \*\* Qualified Awards \*\*

Only SERC kilometres are counted for these awards:

◆ **5: Junior Rider Award**

Awarded to the horse and **junior** rider combination, aged 10-16 as at 1st January, achieving the highest total kilometres ridden under SERC rules in the current season 1st January to 31st December.

◆ **6: Male Rider Award**

Awarded to the horse and male rider combination, achieving the highest total kilometres ridden under SERC rules in the current season 1st January to 31st December.

◆ **7: Nicki's Cup**

Awarded to the **pony 14:2hh and under** and **adult** rider combination, aged 17 years and over achieving the highest total kilometres ridden under SERC rules in the current season 1st January to 31st December.

◆ **8: Veteran Horse Award – 16 years and over**

Awarded to the veteran horse, aged 16 years or over at 1st January season start, achieving the highest total kilometres ridden under SERC rules in the current season 1st January to 31st December.

◆ **9: Veteran Rider Award – 50 years and over**

Awarded to the veteran rider, 50 years and over at 1st January season start, achieving the highest total kilometres ridden under SERC rules in the current season 1st January to 31st December.

**\*\* Dumfries Rides Awards \*\***

◆ **10: Grey Mare Memorial Plate**

Awarded to the **oldest** horse ridden by a Dumfries member, to have successfully completed a Dumfries branch ride, in the current season 1st January to 31st December.

◆ **11: Scotts Garage Trophy**

Awarded to the Dumfries member with the most points in the current season – 1st January to 31st December, calculated by: - 20 points for each time the member has helped at a Dumfries ride, one point for each kilometre successfully completed in a Dumfries pleasure or training ride. To be eligible, rider and horses must not have started a competitive ride in the current season, separately or together.

**\*\* Newcomer Awards \*\***

Only SERC kilometres are counted for these awards:

◆ **12: Newcomer Award**

Awarded to the horse and rider combination, **both** in their **first competitive** season achieving the highest total kilometres ridden under SERC rules in the current season 1st January to 31st December. The combination may have completed several years of pleasure rides, and be eligible, as it is the season in which the first entry is written on the competitive mastercard that counts.

◆ **13: New Combination Award**

Awarded to the horse and rider combination, in their first season together, achieving the highest total kilometres ridden under SERC rules in the current season 1st January to 31st December. I.e. to be eligible, this must be the first season when a ride entry is written on the first mileage card.

**\*\* Type Awards \*\***

Horses are eligible for **ONE** type award only. Horses must stay in the entered category, and not change from year to year.

A horse does not need breed registration papers to qualify for purebred awards as long as they are registered with SERC and are true to type.

Only SERC kilometres are counted for these awards:

◆ **14: Arth Fenella Memorial Trophy**

Awarded to the purebred native pony and rider combination achieving the highest total kilometres ridden under SERC rules in the current season 1st January to 31st December.

◆ **15: Native Type Award**

Awarded to the part-bred native pony and rider combination achieving the highest total kilometres ridden under SERC rules in the current season 1st January to 31st December.

◆ **16: Arab Award**

Awarded to the pure-bred Arab and rider combination achieving the highest total kilometres ridden under SERC rules in the current season 1st January to 31st December.

◆ **17: Part-Bred Arab Award**

Awarded to the part-bred Arab and rider combination achieving the highest total kilometres ridden under SERC rules in the current season 1st January to 31st December.

◆ **18: Thoroughbred Award**

Awarded to the pure or part-bred Thoroughbred and rider combination achieving the highest total kilometres ridden under SERC rules in the current season 1st January to 31st December.

◆ **19: Nimrod Explorer Trophy – Any Other Type 15hh or Under**

Awarded to the horse or pony 15hh or under and rider combination achieving the highest total kilometres ridden under SERC rules in the current season 1st January to 31st December.

◆ **20: Any Other Type Over 15hh Award**

Awarded to the horse over 15hh and rider combination achieving the highest total kilometres ridden under SERC rules in the current season 1st January to 31st December.

◆ **21: Beaujolais Bowl**

Awarded to the coloured horse or pony (spots and/or patches) and rider combination achieving the highest total kilometres ridden under SERC rules in the current season 1st January to 31st December.

**\*\* Competitive Awards \*\***

An explanation of the calculation of points is given in section 18.11 of the current rule book for CTRs and 19.10 for ERs. NB points changed for CTRs in 2009

◆ **22: Golden Fayre Savanna Trophy**

Awarded to the horse and rider combination achieving the highest total number of Gold awards in SERC competitive rides in the current season 1st January to 31st December. In the event of a tie, the combination with the lowest average heart rate over those gold awards will win.

◆ **23: Top Four Trophy**

Awarded to the horse and rider combination achieving the highest total points from their best four competitive (not ER) rides, ridden under either SERC or EGB rules, in the current season 1st January to 31st December. Points calculated as per SERC rules. In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided by using the performance formula for the four rides.

◆ **24: Fenny's Cup**

Awarded to the horse and rider combination achieving the highest total competitive points, not having ridden in classes above the 50 km category, ridden under SERC rules in the current season 1st January to 31st December.

◆ **24: Ben Shah Trophy**

Awarded to the horse and rider combination achieving the highest competitive points, in classes of 60km and above, ridden under SERC rules in the current season 1st January to 31st December.

**\*\* Achievement Awards \*\***

◆ **25: Dumfries Helpers Awards**

**New!** Points awarded for the difficulty and length of task and number of times helped. Doing admin at a ride scores more than opening a gate, for example. All jobs, not just those at rides are included – eg bib washing, doing the packed lunches, towing the admin trailer, representing the branch at meetings, editing the newsletter, organising rides etc etc. List what you have done on the back of the form.

◆ **26: Royal Wonda Award**

Awarded to the individual or horse receiving the most nominations for their achievement during the season by the membership. Members to nominate who they think should receive this award and why. In the event of a tie the branch committee to decide the overall winner.

◆ **27: Worn Tyre Award**

Awarded to the **non-riding** crew attending the most number of SERC rides in the current season 1st January to 31st December.

**\*\* Mileage Rosettes & Medals \*\***

Rosettes are awarded at the branch annual awards night to combinations reaching the following lifetime cumulative kilometres:  
150km, 250km, 500km, 750km, 1000km, and increments of 500km thereafter. (note this last figure changed at the 2006 AGM)

Boxed medals are awarded by the Club committee, but presented locally, for combinations achieving 1500km and increments of 1000km thereafter.

Rosettes awarded to third place where appropriate.

Award forms must be completed and forwarded to the branch archivist by the due date, along with copies of EGB vet sheets, logbook mastercard and kilometres cards in order for trophy claims to be considered. Copies of SERC vet sheets not required.

No late applications will be accepted.
